

Paris Fellowship Program

Le Bureau international de l'édition française, in partnership with Cnl and SOFIA, invites 15 publishers from abroad to spend a professional week in Paris in order to broaden their knowledge of the French book market.

The program takes place in Paris from **March 21st to March 27th 2020**. It's aimed at **15 foreign publishers of Literature and the Humanities**. It proposes:

- "B to B" meetings with French publishers
- Several round tables to discuss the main stakes of both the Humanities and Foreign Literature publishers in France and elsewhere
- Visits of publishing houses and bookshops
- Attending a TV or radio show around the literary scene (if the opportunity arises)

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- To be available from 21 to 27 March 2020 in Paris
- To be preferably under 40
- To be an editorial executive/manager in **Literature or the Humanities (no children books, no YA, no illustrated books)**
- To manage French sufficiently to be able to read a text in French and to understand someone speaking in French
- To be able to express oneself in French or in English

FINANCIAL ASPECTS

- Participants' hotel bills will be paid by BIEF that also pays a per diem (50 €/day)
- Participants will pay their own travelling expenses
